The announcement of Minister Gayton McKenzie was made last night by His Excellency, President Cyril Ramaphosa during the much-anticipated introduction of the Government of Unity new Cabinet.

Meanwhile, the President also announced Ms. Peace Mabe as the new Deputy Minister for the national Department of Sport, Arts and Culture. The incumbent takes over from the former Deputy Minister, Ms Nocawe Mafu.
