RFQ 14 OF 2025: APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION STRATEGY FOR THE NELSON MANDELA MUSEUM.

1. BACKGROUND

The Nelson Mandela Museum (NMM) is a not for profit institution established by the government of South Africa as an agency of the National Department of Sports, Arts and Culture. It was established as part of a portfolio of legacy projects that seek to transform the heritage landscape from our apartheid past. At the same time, it is a resource for promoting economic development through tourism in an impoverished region of the country. The museum primarily houses collections of gifts to the nation given by Nelson Mandela to the museum to share his legacy with the nation.

The mandate of the Nelson Mandela Museum is to preserve and promote the legacy of Nelson Mandela, and one of its main strategic goals is to improve the museum's public profile and access. This mandate is executed through the museum's four main facilities, the Qunu Youth and Heritage Centre, Bhunga Building in Mthatha CBD, Ingquza Hill Museum in Flagstaff, and OR Tambo Garden of Remembrance in Bizana (eNkantolo). The Bhunga Building doubles as the administrative office of the museum.

2. PURPOSE

The NMM ICT department has an approved five-year strategy in alignment with the five-year strategic plan of NMM. In order to guide the digital transformation approach, a digital strategy is required to complement the recently developed ICT strategy and the digital marketing strategy.

The purpose of this RFQ is to develop a digital strategy to guide the digital transformation of NMM services. This will assist in prioritizing areas of the Nelson Mandela Museum that will benefit from digitization. The ICT strategy outlines the digital strategy framework, which must then be developed to address different areas of digital transformation, giving NMM a clear implementation or modernization roadmap. The digital strategy must address the digital marketing and ICT strategic aspect.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1 Develop digital transformation strategy that will incorporate cloud migration and cybersecurity strategy to improve the value of strategic assets of the NMM. The strategy should conceal the improvement of the values of NMM strategic assets through the adoption of digital transformation taking into consideration of the following but not limited to;
 - Regulatory Mandate
 - Brand value
 - Organization culture
 - Stakeholder network
- **3.2** Define digital strategy vision, engagement and governance
 - Define governance structure and organizational engagement programmes
 - Define digital strategy vision for the Nelson Mandela Museum.
- **3.3** Develop the digital strategy to improve operational processes
 - Investigate processes that are due for automation.
 - Recommend an intelligent automation of jobs and/or functions that can be performed better by computers to allow staff members to do advanced jobs.
 - Explore work planning, collaborating tools to share information and communicate internally and externally
 - Investigate performance dashboards and analytics to allow the view of the business performance against set targets.
 - Investigate digital instruments that improves human workflows

 Identify the performance tracking, reporting and enforcement using technology

3.4 Develop the digital strategy to transform the business model

- Review the enterprise architecture roadmap and report on digital transformation progress
- Investigate the operational model and how technology can improve business models (decentralised assessment and automation thereof)
- Explore digital opportunities for a development centred products as compared to registration products.
- Report on opportunities for digitisation for both broadly and in terms of quick wins

The service provider will be accountable to and under the direction of the CEO of the NMM in the performance of the assigned duties.

8. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Criterion 1- Compulsory Requirements

Bidders will first be evaluated in terms of the gatekeeper/minimum requirements stipulated. Bidders who do not fulfil all the requirements or do not submit the required documents will be disqualified. Those who fulfil all the requirements or have submitted the required documents will be further evaluated on functionality.

Criterion 2- Functionality

Functionality is worth 100 points. The **minimum threshold is 70 points**. Bidders who score less than 70 points on functionality will therefore not be evaluated further. Those who score 70 points or more will be evaluated in terms of price and preference points (points allocated for specific goals). The functionality evaluation is broken down as follows:

- 1.5 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.
- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based

- on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
